License Renewal is open

We hope this newsletter finds you and your businesses doing well as we near the end of 2018 and prepare for a successful 2019. Remember there are two ways to renew your license(s); you can print a 2019 License renewal form off of our website or the most efficient way is to renew online through our website: www.aowb.alabama.gov. Keep in mind, to renew online, you must make sure that we have received your continuing education and bond information, otherwise, the online system will not process your payment for the renewal. If needed, you can also call our office and we will be happy to mail a renewal application to you.

As we communicated to you previously, we found out that almost all the Insurance Bonding Agencies are no longer sending a renewal/continuation of our licensee's bonds to the Oblige or 3rd party (which is AOWB). It would seem reasonable that since you must pay them for this policy that they would assist you in forwarding a copy to the requiring agency. Some of you have received a letter from us regarding bond suspension. If your policy has not had a lapse in coverage, most likely, your insurance company did not send a notice of continuance to our office. Please call our office to verify that you have renewed your bond and then also call your Insurance agency and request they fax the continuation to our office, so your license will not reflect a status of "Suspended". Also, when it is time for you to renew your bond, please ask your insurance agency to fax a copy to AOWB at (334)353-0122.

Your Alabama Onsite Wastewater Board is here for you! If you have any questions or need any assistance with renewal, our office is only a phone call away (334)353-9250.

As a reminder, your license must be renewed prior to December 13th in order to avoid a \$100 late fee; if it is not renewed prior to February 16th, you will also accrue a \$250 penalty fee.
